

# The best ways to revise for GCSE Science

## Terminology:

- Ensure you **understand** the meaning of key **scientific vocabulary** and know which questions to use it in
- Glossaries of key terms for all topics are available from Physics and Maths tutor for free

## Content:

- **Summarise** content onto flashcards and regularly practice recalling key content.
- CPG sell pre-made flashcards covering the entirety of Trilogy and Triple Science courses.

## Identify weaker areas:

- Use **personalised learning checklists**, available from your teachers, to identify areas you are less confident in.
- Target these weaker areas in your revision.

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## Practicals:

- Understand why you have done a practical and know the key ideas behind it
- Practice recalling the methods of all required practicals

## Practice:

- Practice exam questions and mark your answers using the mark scheme.
- Take notice of the key words included in the mark scheme and ensure your answers contain them.

## Do:

- Do as many Tassomai questions as possible to improve recall.
- Recall covers around one third of the content in exams.
