- To collaborate with peers at school and in other less familiar settings
- To be a positive role model in terms of punctuality, organisation, reliability and behaviour
- To be resilient and open to new experiences, ideas and ways of learning

- Providing solutions to issues independently of staff
- Having the confidence to take the lead
- Communicating the work of the team to the wider community eg via assembly, newsletter, presentation.
